



During the new “daily life”, approximately 50% of employees of the Central Office facilities took advantage of the occupational safety protocol to resume their work in person.

One by one, and keeping the distance of two meters, they arrived. Dr. Mario Santana, an occupational physician, was waiting for them at the entrance of the main building; There he measured body temperature, and gave them a protective goggle and two reusable masks; and at the same time that it recommended not to wear earrings, watches, rings, bracelets or necklaces, among other instructions to avoid the spread of Covid - 19.

In this way, the departments of: Attorney General's Office, Finance, Accounting, Comprehensive Security, Engineering and Maintenance, Real Estate Management, buildings, Selection and contracting, Management, Secretary, Internal Audit, Operations with the public sector, International Relations, Marketing and Institutional Communication, Transformation and Systems, Acquisitions, Land, Treasury, Medical Audit and Human Talent.

Within the socialization of work reintegration, it was specified that personnel who are within vulnerable groups, such as people with disabilities, with catastrophic degenerative or immunosuppressed diseases, pregnancy, lactation and those over 60 years old were excluded from face-to-face work.
