



More and more disabled Ecuadorians receive from Junta de Beneficencia de Guayaquil mobility aids donated in coordination with international cooperation.

One of the benefited institutions was the Municipality of Urdaneta in Los Ríos Province; which received 7 non-folding wheelchairs, 7 walkers, and 3 canes. The Mayor of Urdaneta, Mrs. Amada Zambrano, thanked Junta de Beneficencia de Guayaquil for its initiative and said that these implements will improve the quality of life of disabled people in the rural sector.



On the other hand, in the eastern part of the country, Junta de Beneficencia de Guayaquil donated medicine, medical supplies, 11 mechanically powered cars, 2 pairs of crutches, 8 walkers, and 27 canes. This donation will benefit the residents of the "Monsignor Tomás Romero Gross Home" as well as the patients who are treated at the "Santa Narcisa de Jesús" clinic. Both institutions are run by the Apostolic Vicariate of Puyo, capital of the Province of Pastaza.
