



On this occasion, 43 persons from the sectors of Cristóbal Colón, Santa Rosa, January 10, Taura, Luz y Vida, Las Delicias and other rural areas of Naranjal County in the Guayas Province; received 25 all-terrain wheelchairs, 14 canes, 4 walkers, and a batch of medical supplies for physical therapy, from **Junta de Beneficencia de Guayaquil - JBG** - through **Naranjal's Central Autonomous Government – GAD** - .

One of the beneficiaries, was Zoila Tigre who, since the beginning of this year, had been knocking doors of several organizations for a wheelchair that would allow her to carry out her activities and transportation to the dialysis she needs due to kidney failure.

On behalf of the Mayor, Luigi Rivera expressed his gratitude to **Junta de Beneficencia de Guayaquil**, highlighting the

openness and solidarity that
