Jose Murillo, 73 years old, was still moving around with crutches he had improvised. A poorly administered injection at the age of 8 months interrupted his mobility; however this did not prevent him from developing certain skills and perform agricultural labor in Portoviejo.

“I am grateful because this little car will be of great help in going to school and his therapy sessions as well as making him feel more useful and independent,” expressed Erika Chango mother of 10 year-old John Chila suffering from Larsen’s syndrome and who received his PET balance wheel tricycle.
