Ana Ramón, a member of the residential team contacted the children who, on hearing the news, could not hold tears and emotions back. Their mother was alive!

A few days later, Luz Barberan's children visited the Neurosciences Institute with mixed emotions, nervous but with a smile on their faces for an emotional reencounter. After this visit all pertinent procedures for Luz to return home with her children were taken care of.

We do not know why she was abandoned or why their grandfather lied, but we have the certainty, the pride and joy of having restored a smile, and a home, having done what many believed impossible which is to reunite the children with their mother after 25 years and that is what matters.
